

# **Downtown Incentive Programs**

The City of Shawnee has a variety of economic development incentive programs designed to enhance, encourage, and stimulate redevelopment and new economic opportunities in the downtown area. Programs include:

### **Shawnee Downtown Tax Rebate**

Through the City's Neighborhood Revitalization Tax Rebate Program, new or expanded properties can receive up to 90% of eligible property taxes forgiven for a period of ten years. This often equates to between 15 - 25% of the construction value of the project over time.

## **Downtown Improvement Grants**

The Downtown Partnership Grant Program provides remodeling improvement grants to business or property owners who invest more than \$10,000. The grants are either \$2,000 or \$5,000 increments and are competitively allocated each year. Eligible improvements include: façade restoration, window/doors, awnings, signage, lighting, landscaping, among others.

### **Loan Buy-Down Program**

Downtown residential and commercial property owners may receive loans between \$5 - 50,000 through a local bank partnership for renovation or building improvements. The Downtown Improvement Loan will be 1.5% below normal market rates by the institution. Eligible improvements include: façade restoration, window/doors, awnings, signage, lighting, landscaping, among others.

### **Fire Safety Program**

To improve public safety in the downtown area with typically older structures, the City has a program to partially offset a portion of installing a new fire line for a fire sprinkler system. Up to 20% of the cost of a new system, up to \$5,000, will be reimbursed for structures built before 2000.

### **Shawnee Restaurant Incentive**

Shawnee wishes to assist new and expanding restaurants in the downtown area by reimbursing a portion of the costs associated with grease interceptor installation. The City will reimburse up to \$2,500 towards the cost of new purchase and installation of a grease interceptor or trap system. The program does not cover repair or maintenance of existing systems and the new system must not be removed for five years.

## **Other City Programs**

The City of Shawnee has additional incentive programs available throughout the community like the SEED Forgivable Loan program (requires 10 new jobs), real property tax abatement (new construction valued over \$1.5 million), Property Tax Assistance Program or the Lease Assistance Program (limited for certain industries) that businesses in the downtown Shawnee area may also be eligible for.
